

Verbs in Agreement

 ${\bf S}$ is sometimes added to a verb when one person or thing is doing the action. If more than one person or thing is doing the action, no ${\bf s}$ added to the verb.

Examples: The kid throw<u>s</u> the baseball. The kid**s** shook_hands.
